Projects:

We have received materials for the filter media remediation. The contractor is here and 2 of the 3 filters are done. They should be done next week. We have also been cleaning out our backwash ponds for the last 2 weeks. This should only have to be done once every 3 years.

The next line relocation from Pensacola to Langley is ready to start. All the pipe and materials have been delivered. They are starting to get equipment here and have started locates. We will be starting in Pensacola with the road bores and will move east to Langley.

We are also having to pull our lake pumps again. We did this last year, but have developed a short in one pump. I am having one pump reworked and also ordered a new pump. We have already replaced the drive on the bad motor. We will also be pulling pump 3 because it is currently running at half flow. Regardless, I have all the parts that could be needed.

Last month we repaired 4 water leaks, changed 0 regulators, set 3 meters, moved 0 meters, replaced 1 meter cans, changed 0 cut-off valves, changed 0 smartpoints, and processed 29 locates. The total water loss for last month was 53%, and the adjusted after leak repairs was 46%. We are a just about caught up on repairing leaks. We will continue to look for loss in the district.
